Dear Parent/Guardian/Caregiver,

At this point, we are certain you have heard a tremendous amount of information about the novel coronavirus (COVID-19). The virus has had a worldwide impact with the majority of cases coming out of China, Iran, South Korea, Japan and Italy.

Lifespire Inc. has been reviewing the information from the CDC (Centers for Disease and Control), the WHO (World Health Organization), and the NYS and NYC Departments of Health. There is currently no vaccine to prevent against COVID-19. The best way to prevent infection is to take every day preventative actions, like avoiding close contact with people who are sick and washing your hands often, in other words, "universal precautions".
